



- •44% have service-connected disability.
 - •47% of those have disability rating >60%. 17
 - •Disabilities associated with psychological distress (e.g., depression, PTSD, and stress associated with finances). 18
 - These issues add to transition stress.

- •45,000 veterans and active-duty committed suicide over the past six years--more than 20 per day. 19
- •Strong link between transition stress and suicide rate.²⁰
- •Suicide hazard 2.5 times higher within first year of separation. ^{21,22}

Fewer years of education = higher suicide hazard when compared to those with a Bachelor's.²¹

Veteran Opportunity

- CCC Fall 2021: 26,306 veterans and active-duty military enrolled.
 - 15 units saves \$902 million benefits. 1 unit of credit saves \$2,287.
- U.S. 2020: 156,232 veterans started higher education journey.⁸
 - 15 units saves \$3.875 billion⁹ benefits = (156,232 X \$1,654 * 15).¹⁰

CPL = BA/BS, MA/MS, doctorate, or advanced certification

CA MAP Initiative Cohort

76 Colleges serve 17,287 (74%) of the 23,463 CCC GI Bill Recipients to begin to:

- Change policy, procedure, and personnel to facilitate CPL.
- Process JSTs and non-military certs to articulate & award in MAP.
- Align system policies to ensure transfer (CCC, CSU, UC).
- Adopt Articulations from each other (equitable treatment).
- Offer guided pathways with embedded CPL.
- ☐ Flip the CPL process (colleges petition students)...AND

SCO Handbook and Prior Credit

"One of the criteria for approval of any school for Veterans' training is that it reviews prior credit and grant credit as appropriate to a VA student's current program."

"...Schools <u>must evaluate prior credit, grant credit as appropriate, notify the student of the evaluation, and shorten the program certified accordingly</u>. Whenever a student initially enrolls in your school or changes programs at your school a credit evaluation must be completed. <u>VA will review credit evaluations during compliance surveys and credit evaluation records must be kept and made available to VA upon request</u>."

"Schools should <u>make every effort to obtain transcripts</u> to comply with the requirement to evaluate and grant credit where appropriate.

"Reviews of prior credit policies will be conducted during compliance surveys and treated as approval issues if the school is not complying."











CCC CPL Mandate

Mandate: Assessment of Prior Learning

Title 5 55050 Item (j) ...a student, upon completion of their educational plan...shall be referred to the college's appropriate authority for assessment of prior learning if the student is a veteran or an active-duty member of the armed forces, holds industry-recognized credentials, or requests credit for a course based on their prior learning.



Joint Services Transcript Academic Institutions

Academic Institutions

1. View Transcripts Online

JST offers online accounts to learning institutions enabling access to service-member's official transcripts at no cost. The transcript on the web is exactly the same as the transcript you receive in the mail. Transcripts ordered are available for viewing/downloading the next business day and an e-mail is automatically sent to the points-of-contact at your institution to inform them that there are transcripts available online at the secure website.

Please note that authorization is not being granted for an institution to order transcripts, only to access them online once they have been ordered. Students can order transcripts online by authorizing release or they can fill out a request form for an official JST, with a signature to authorize the release of the transcript.

2. Order Transcripts Online

Your account can be upgraded to permit you to order transcripts as well as view them online if you meet the one of the following conditions:

- Prospective students agree to allow your institution to request all transcripts on their behalf. Permission can be obtained via the checkbox on the student application or on the web. You can fax or e-mail a blank application showing the section where the prospective student would grant this authorization.
- Your institution agrees to not order transcripts unless they have a signed release from the service member. This requirement can be satisfied by sending an e-mail to us stating you promise to never order an official transcript without a signed release from the service member.

3. Establishing an Account

Our policy has recently changed. To have an account established to enable online viewing of official JSTs for your institution, we will need a request form filled out for each user requesting a login and sent back to JST. You can download a copy of the form here: Academic Institution Form.

You have several options of getting the form back to JST. You may fax, mail or email this document to us.

- 4. Legislation for state and national minimum of 3 courses or 12 units CPL awarded to all Service members upon honorable discharge.
- 5. Incorporate Common Course Numbering in MAP.
- 6. Build MAP Team capacity for CPL Service Center for students and colleges.
- 7. Provide a national voice and solution to optimize CPL in U.S. IHLs.










